




Medium Star




Dark Star




Making the Pieced Triangles Squares




1. On the wrong side of the (4) 6" Background squares draw a 3" grid.
2. Draw diagonal lines from corner to corner.




3. With right sides together, pair up marked Background squares with (2) 6" Pinwheel squares, (1) Medium Star square and (1) 6" Dark Star Square.



4. Sew ¼" from the diagonally drawn lines. Set seams.
5. Cut apart on all drawn lines.




6. Press open with seams away from Background fabric.
7. Square up all patches to 2½".




Sewing the Stars Together

Making the Two Dark Stars

1. Lay out the patches for the Dark Star.
2. Sew to complete Rows. Press seams toward Star fabric.




3. Sew Rows together. Press seams toward Center Row.




Making the Two Medium Stars

1. Lay out patches for the Medium Star.
2. Sew to complete Rows. Press seam toward Pinwheel fabric and Center square.



3. Sew Rows together. Press seams away from Center Row.



Completing the Block

1. Lay out Stars.
2. Sew together and press seams toward Medium Stars.
